## Pale Glitter:

To make a long story short ... "Pale Glitter" is one of the most perfect pop albums out there. Miwon embraces his long history of recording and experimenting with electronic music and merges it all into one big irresistable wall of catchy sounds and tunes. "Hush" and the title track "Pale Glitter" are deep, minimal dancefloor killers, while "When Angels Travel" drags the more experimental side of Miwon's sound out of the dark, polishes them until they fit into this last man on earth soundtrack. Then there is "No Need For Sanity", a remix Miwon did for Pia Fraus, a band from Estonia and which already made a big buzz in Japan.
